Carlos G. Chavez Jr., age 70, of Kingsville, Texas, peacefully passed away on January 2, 2024, at his home surrounded by his family after a long battle with cancer. Born on November 16, 1953, in Alton, Texas, he was the beloved son of Carlos and Tomasita Chavez Sr.

He was an extremely hard worker, dedicated and determined to provide for his family and give them the life they deserved. Carlos was a retired carpenter and the owner and operator of Chavez & Sons Construction. In his previous years, he was employed with K.I.S.D. He was a devoted father and grandfather who created a nickname for everyone. His family meant more to him than anything else in the world and he was unendingly proud of his children.
