He was born on October 26, 1965 in Corpus Christi, TX to Pedro and Esperanza Jimenez Jr.

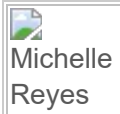
He was preceded in death by two brothers, Domingo Jimenez, and Pedro Jimenez III; and one sister, Teodeosa Garza.
